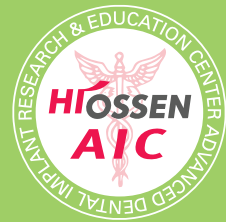

 - Ridge augmentation, sinus grafts, CAS Kit, LAS Kit
 - Treatment planning principles & managing complications
 - Radiology, CT scans, & pharmacology
2. Hands-on
 - Learning prosthetic components in plastic jaws
 - Impression of implants in plastic models

Day 3

- Morning : Doctors observe and assist on live patient surgeries**
- Afternoon : Doctors perform live patient surgeries with supervision**

Day 4

- Doctors perform live patient surgeries on their own patients with their own CDAs
- Each student is encouraged to bring at least one patient
- Case review and wrap up
